## A BILL

To prohibit the Department of Defense from entering into contracts for the provision of online tutoring services with companies owned or controlled by nationals or government officials of certain countries, and for other purposes.

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE CON-
2	TRACTS WITH CERTAIN FOREIGN-OWNED ON-
3	LINE TUTORING SERVICES.
4	(a) Prohibition on Contracts.—Beginning on the
5	date that is 60 days after the date of the enactment of
6	this Act, the Department of Defense may not enter into
7	a contract for the provision of online tutoring services with
8	a company of concern.
9	(b) TERMINATION OF EXISTING CONTRACTS.—In the
10	case of any contract between the Department of Defense
11	and a company of concern for the provision of online tutor-
12	ing service that is entered into before the date that is 60
13	days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec-
14	retary of Defense shall terminate such contract as soon
15	as is legally possible.
